Climb for children

CHILDREN with cerebral palsy will never be able to climb a mountain such as Kilimanjaro – so the descendants of Sir Edmund Hillary are doing it for them. The Humpty Dumpty Foundation will be returning to Mount Kilimanjaro for the second consecutive year with Peter and Amelia Hillary, Sir Edmund's son and granddaughter, and Jamling Tenzing, son of Sherpa Tenzing Norgay who climbed Mt Everest with Hillary. The trek is on from Thursday July 29 to Tuesday August 10. Aim is to raise \$1 million for a centre at The Children's Hospital at Westmead dedicated to the assessment of children with cerebral palsy.
